Dress Code: All campers are expected to dress appropriately to a standard similar as would be required at school.

Snacks: Due to food allergies, no food is permitted to be brought to camp by campers.

Meals: Nutritious balanced meals are served from a modern kitchen in a supervised dining hall. Any child that requires a special diet should make sure that **advance preparation** is made with the Cook.

Medications: All medications must be turned over to the camp's First Aid Coordinator upon arrival at camp.

Discipline Policy: All campers are required to behave in a manner that maintains and promotes an environment of safety, love, and respect for staff, campers and the property. When any serious disciplinary action is required, parents will be notified and if unacceptable behavior continues, a camper may be required to leave the camp.

Cabins: Campers live with a group of fellow campers in cabins under the supervision of qualified and **trained staff.**

Visiting Camp: Visiting your child at camp is not encouraged except on opening and closing days. Visitation tends to interrupt the daily camp schedule. However, if you feel that it is necessary to do so, please contact the Camp Director to make the arrangements.

Campers are advised to mark all belongings – the Camp will not be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged articles. At the end of the camping season, all unclaimed articles will be donated to a charity.

Refund Policy: If your child does not attend camp after registering; the following policy regarding refunds will apply: Notification within ten (10) days prior to camp, 80% refund. After that time, no refund will be given. An appeal to this ruling may be considered by the Board at the September meeting. A written appeal must be received by the Board Chair in writing no later than September 15.

Location: Camp Abegweit is located at 140 Camp Abegweit Road, Augustine Cove, P.E.I.

Directions from Summerside

- On 1A, turn right to merge onto Route 1 towards Bordon. Travel 4.3 km.
- Turn left on Route 10 and travel for approximately 7.5 km.
- Turn right on Richard Point Road - Camp Abby sign on Route 10 at the end of Richard Pt. Rd.
- Slight left at Camp Abegweit Road - 0.6km

Directions from Charlottetown

- Turn left at the corner of University St and at PE-1 W/Trans-Canada Hwy (signs for Borden-Carleton) Travel 37.6km,
- Turn left at Route 10 N 220m, turn left to stay on PE-10 N for 4.8km.
- Turn left at Richard Point Rd 700m
- Take the 1st left onto Camp Abegweit Rd

Arrival and Departure Times: Please check below for arrival and departure times for the various camps. *Please honor these times as staffing is scheduled around arrival and departure hours.*

For the 3 day camp, July 24th – 26th drop off time July 24th is 9:00 AM with pickup time at 5:00 PM that same day. July 25th – drop off time is 9:00 AM with pick up time on July 26th at 5:00 PM.

For 5 day camps, drop off time is at 3:00 PM on the day the camp starts with pick up at 3:00 PM on the last day of the camp.

For Day Camps, drop off time is between 7:30 am and 8:30 am pickup time is by 5 pm

***Day Camp is available on Friday but pick-up time is by 3:00 pm*
